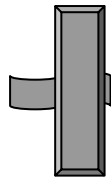

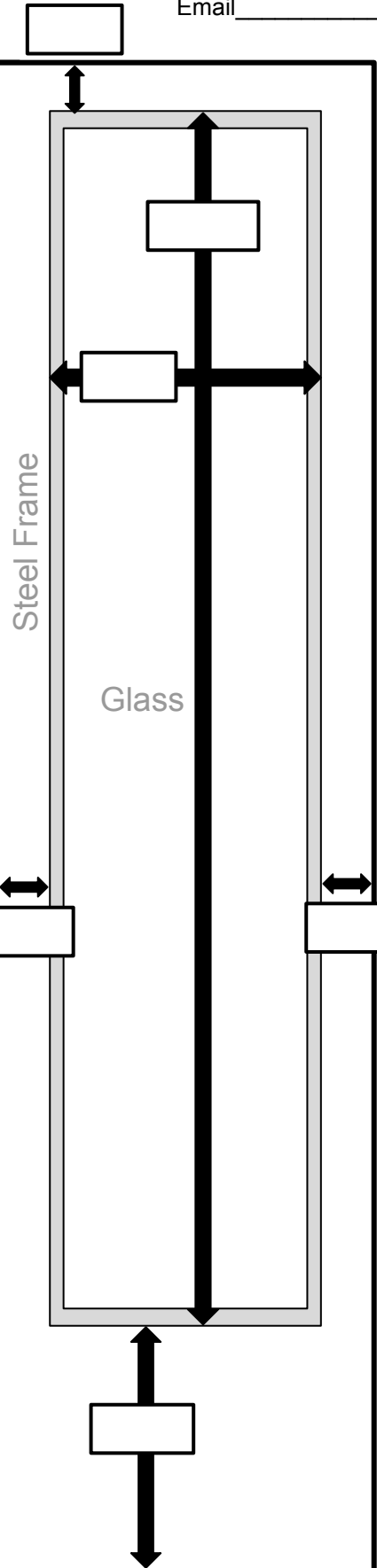
Quantity of identical openings _____

Measure inside of the steel frame. (not inside the stop molding holding the glass in place).

Shelter Shutters for sidelight windows less than 60" long will grab the steel frame of the sidelight securely when closed. Shutters over 60" in length will come with special neodymium adhesive plates that can be installed onto the steel sidelight to hold the shutter secure in the closed position if needed.

The steel frame around school sidelights is an ideal surface for Shelter Shutters. This typically 2" wide steel surface allows for the shutter to adhere to the steel with the pressure tape and also gives the working section of the shutter a wide steel face for the shutters' magnets to hold onto.

When retracted and in the open position a multi fold shutter will block less than one third the glass width. A single fold shutter will block less than half the glass.
